### George Crabbe Poetry Competition Rules

- Entry to the competition is open to anyone who is either born, educated, working or resident in Suffolk, Norfolk, Essex, or is a Suffolk Poetry Society member (see information below).
- Entries can be made online at suffolkpoetrysociety.org/sps-shop
- Poems will be in English and a maximum of 50 lines.
- Poems must be the writer's own work, not published, broadcast, on a website or currently entered in any other competition.
- Each poem submitted by post must be typed on a separate sheet of A4 paper and submitted in DUPLICATE along with the fee. The poet's name must appear on one copy only.
- The adjudicator's decision is final.
- No entrant can win more than one monetary prize.
- Only winners will be notified. Winners will be listed on the SPS website in September.
- The Press may also be notified of the winning poets and poems.
- Copyright of the poems remains with the poets, with permission to Suffolk Poetry Society to publish any winning poem free of charge.
